Any orders placed after this two-week period will be sent directly to your specified delivery address and will incur a \$6.00 postage and packing charge. You will see this message when you on Online to view and order your photographs.

Sibling photo forms will be available from the school office from 18th October, Day 1 of Term 4. These can be sent home on request.
